Call for Abstracts

The Kuala Lumpur BIO/ICT-Asia Workshop offers four plenary sessions that include panel discussions on the following four areas of interest (AOI): Biomass and Renewable Energies, Cybersecurity, Green Smart Cities, Health & Wellbeing.

Participants of the BIO/ICT-Asia Workshop are scientists in the specified fields of research, notably researchers seeking for regional partners for new collaborative research projects, as well as Heads of International Relations of public and private research bodies.

Speakers will be selected through the present call for abstracts.

Each session will consist of a maximum of five Oral Presentations. Presentations in the specified AOI may focus on ICT research works (fundamental research, models, applications, etc.) and/or Biology-related approaches (biology, biotechnologies, biometrics, biochemistry, biodiversity studies, etc.).**Cross-cutting research approaches are highly encouraged**.

Presentations will last for 15 minutes (10-minute presentation on the scientific work and 5minute discussion on the past or potential collaboration). Group presentations will be considered. If accepted, the presentation time will be extended by 5 minutes. Abstracts will also be considered for Poster Presentations that will be conducted throughout the Workshop.

- 2. **Details of authors' names and affiliations**. Please provide the potential speaker's e-mail and mailing address as well as telephone contact.
- Content (<300 words). Include an introduction, concise details of methods and results, potential/past benefits from the cooperation between Asian or French research units, conclusions and references. The potential or past benefits from the cooperation must be clearly highlighted.
- 4. Speaker's Biography and Photo.
